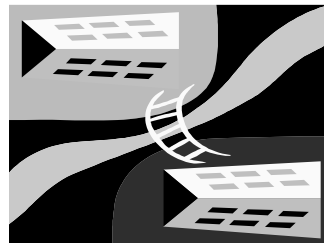

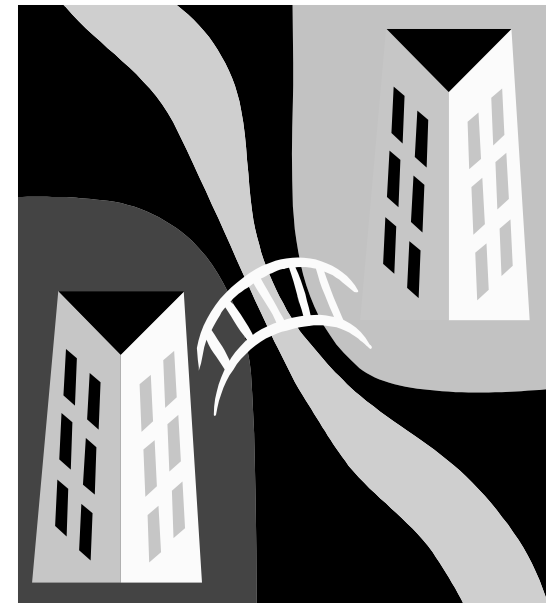

Student Employment Options

Cooperative Work Experience (Co-Op)

This type of paid work experience gives students a true learning opportunity for the transition from school to post secondary education to training and ultimately work.

Internship

Students may gain an in-depth view of a career by participating in unpaid work experience for 80 hours. This experience is generally scheduled outside of the school day and can last for ten weeks, one semester, or one year.



Youth Apprenticeship

Students may enter a two-year paid apprenticeship program at the end of their sophomore year.

Students qualify for this program based on coursework, grades and attendance.

Community Service

Students can participate in 80 hours of unpaid community service and must keep a log and create a project depicting their project in its completion.
